January

Martin Luther King Celebration Parade

Freeport's annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration Parade commemorates the memory and legacy of one of America's most important civil rights leaders. The parade, held in mid-January, starts in downtown

San Jacinto Day Festival

Freeport Riverfest
