Easter After Dark

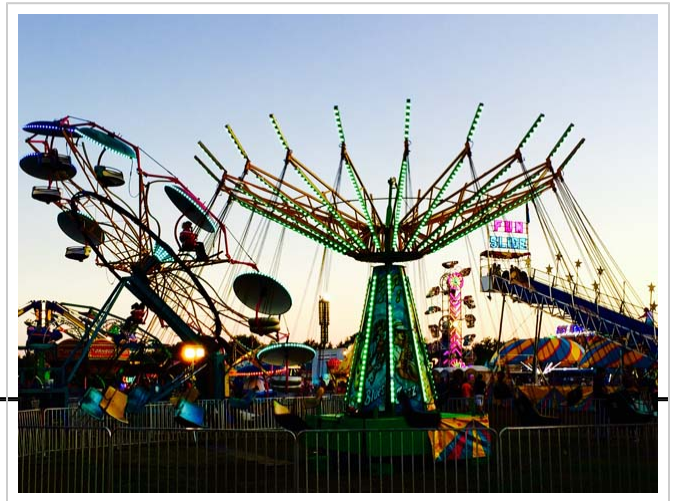
