The Cynthia Woods Mitchell Pavilion is a unique outdoor auditorium known as one of the premier concert venues in the Houston area. Throughout each year, the pavilion hosts big-name acts like Journey, Mumford & Sons, Van Halen, and Drake along with performances by the Houston Symphony and Houston Ballet. In addition to its 17,000 seats, the pavilion has open seating on a hill that overlooks the stage, setting it apart as a one-of-a-kind arena.

Located near the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Pavilion, the boat house offers rentals of single and tandem kayaks throughout the year. From the boat house, you'll paddle through a scenic canal flanked by tall grass and pine trees until you reach the lake, where your adventure begins.
