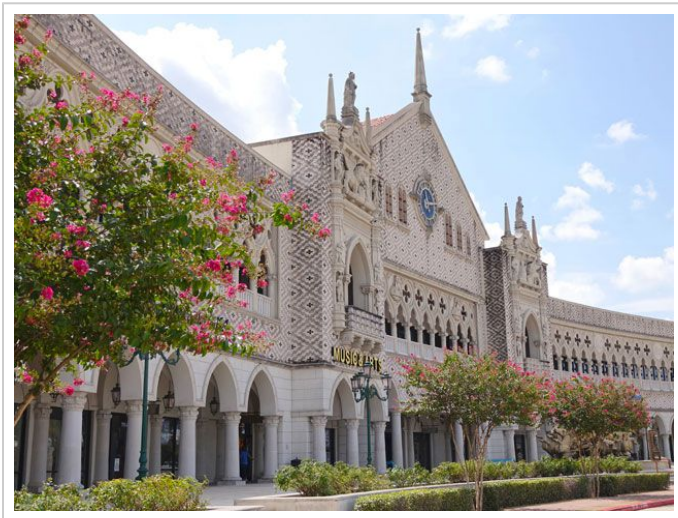

Shenandoah



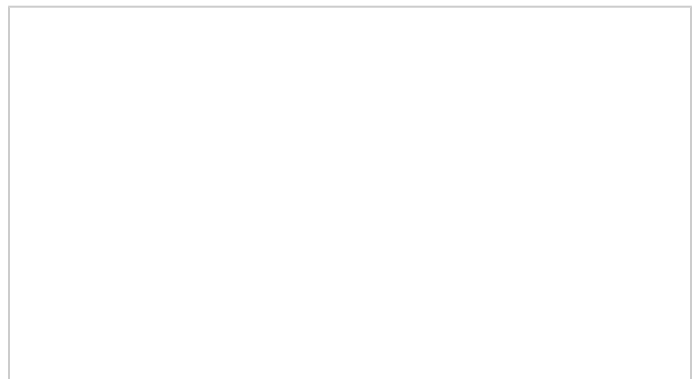
With its outstanding location, accommodations that appeal to both business and leisure travelers, and an impressive mix of shopping, dining, and entertainment, Shenandoah, Texas, is a hidden gem that delivers exceptional value for visitors to the greater North Houston / Woodlands area.

At just over two square miles in size, everything in Shenandoah is easily accessible and convenient. Visitors will find a variety of well-reviewed hotels, more than 60 restaurants, and a diverse mix of shopping and entertainment options to enjoy.

Shenandoah has become a hotspot for indoor entertainment, with nine exciting venues—five of which opened in 2024 and 2025—cementing the city as a destination for big-time fun. Visitors can catch an IMAX movie at AMC, take on game show challenges at Game Show Battle Rooms, zipline indoors at Urban Air Adventure Park, or enjoy bowling at Main Event. From virtual reality at Dave & Buster’s and pottery painting at Color Me Mine, to hands-on play at Cheeky Monkeys, puzzle-solving at Escapology, and immersive challenge rooms at BRKTHROUGH, there is truly something for everyone. In Shenandoah, family-friendly fun is always just around the corner.

Shopping enthusiasts will also find plenty to explore. Portofino and the Sam Moon Shopping Center anchor the city’s retail scene. Portofino features more than 40 shops and restaurants, including Nordstrom Rack, PGA Tour Superstore, and T.J. Maxx. The Sam Moon Center is home to Sam Moon Trading Co., a destination for women’s accessories, jewelry, and apparel—along with value-focused retailers such as Style Encore, Once Upon a Child, and Plato’s Closet.

Shenandoah’s dining scene delivers. With more than 60 restaurants, the city provides a diverse list of cuisines, price points and dining experiences, including everything from locally-owned favorites to well-known regional and national establishments. These range from quick-service and fast/casual concepts to casual and fine dining restaurants—including those led by James Beard-nominated chefs. It’s an unexpected and impressive fact that foodies appreciate and value.



Beyond the city limits, Shenandoah provides easy access to surrounding destinations. Many of The Woodlands' top attractions, shopping districts, and dining areas are just one to three miles from Shenandoah hotels. Both downtown Conroe and Old Town Spring/Six Flags Hurricane Harbor are approximately ten miles away. Shenandoah's central location and value make it an ideal hub for those looking to explore the surrounding area, whether for a day trip, weekend getaway, or an extended family vacation.

When it's time to slow down, Shenandoah offers opportunities to relax and recharge. The city is home to the Aveda Institute, one of the nation's largest Aveda training campuses. Guests can enjoy salon and spa services at reduced rates while students—closely supervised by master-level instructors—gain hands-on experience. For those who prefer spending time in the outdoors, Shenandoah also has several parks you can enjoy, and its urban trail system connects with The Woodlands trail network, offering convenient options for walking and biking. Additionally, several nature preserves, state parks and lakes are located nearby. They include Lake Conroe and the W.G. Jones State Forest in Conroe, as well as Lake Woodlands and the George Mitchell Nature Preserve in The Woodlands.

Finally, Shenandoah operates a state-recognized visitor center located in the city's Municipal Complex at 29955 I-45 North. Open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., the center offers local and Texas travel information, and their staff is always happy to assist with trip planning and recommendations..
