## Fun Things To Do Around League City

**Enjoy Nature:** League City offers a dozen parks, with three on the Great Texas Coastal Birding Trail. See an alligator or marvel at Gulf Coast wildflowers along the trails at Dr. Ned and Fay Dudley Clear Creek Nature Center, or at nearby Armand Bayou Nature Center, home to more than 370 species of birds, mammals, reptiles and amphibians.

**Get Wet:** Canoe or kayak Clear Creek or Armand Bayou. Take a Clear Lake cruise. Or get out on the bay, by sail or speedboat. We're surrounded by water, and the fishing's good, too.

**Catch a Thrill:** Kemah Boardwalk offers waterfront dining and fun, including midway games and rides, and it's right around the corner. Almost as close is Galveston Island's Schlitterbahn water park, where you can drift the Lazy River or test your courage on a nearly-vertical water slide.

**Reach For The Stars:** Explore the universe at Space Center Houston at NASA's Johnson Space Center, where Mission Control guided America's astronauts into space for nearly 50 years ("Houston" was the first word spoken on the moon!)



**Take A Swing:** Big League Dreams features six baseball fields designed as replicas of famous major league stadiums; visit for a tournament or just stop in for a pick-up game. If golf is your preference, we offer 72 holes at three fine courses, including a lighted course for when there's just not enough daylight.

**Go Back In Time:** Experience life at the turn of the 20th century at the West Bay Common School Children's Museum. Learn how a local rancher saved the famous Texas Longhorns at the Butler Longhorn Museum. Or visit League City's Historic District, where boutique shops and restaurants nestle amid century-old oaks.
